- 5. Textiles Minister Smriti Irani has inaugurated 8th India International Silk Fair on Virtual Portal. It is India's biggest silk fair, being held under one roof on Indian Silk Export Promotion Council.
- 6. Microsoft has launched new India Development Center (IDC) facility of Microsoft in Noida, Uttar Pradesh. This centre in NCR is the third development center of Microsoft in India after Bengaluru and Hyderabad. It will serve as a leading hub for driving advanced engineering and innovation.
- 7. Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu has inaugurated Aadi Mahotsav, a National Tribal Festival today at Dilli Haat in INA in Delhi. Aadi Mahotsav - A Celebration of the Spirit of Tribal Culture, Crafts, Cuisine and Commerce is a successful annual initiative that was commenced in 2017.
- 8. Centre for Wetland Conservation and Management (CWCM) has been established at National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM), Chennai
- 9. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh inaugurates 13th edition of three-day mega Aero show event that is taking place for the first time in a hybrid mode (physical + virtual) due to Covid-19 Pandemic. Aero show 2021 is Asia's largest defence and aerospace air show. It is being hosted by Bengaluru, Karnataka.
- 10. Union Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar informed Lok Sabha about Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) organised KRITAGYA- a National level hackathon. KRITAGYA was introduced in August 2020 to promote innovation in agriculture and allied sectors in the country.
- 11.PM Narendra Modi will inaugurate Chauri Chaura Centenary Celebrations at Chauri Chaura, Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh, on 4th Feb 2021 marking 100 years of 'Chauri Chaura' incident. - 12. Union Budget 2021-22 has proposed setting up of 100 new Sainik Schools in India, in partnership with NGOs, private schools and State-owned schools.
- 13. Premier medical institution in Chandigarh, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER) has launched first 'amputee clinic' in India. 'PGI Amputee Clinic' has been set up with the aim of improving amputation patient care by providing a collection of services under one roof with significant coordination.

It will come into effect from Jan 1, 2022
- 28.PM Narendra Modi will inaugurate 2nd edition of Maritime India Summit-2021 on 2nd March. The summit will be participated by around 20,000 delegates, 24 partner countries and more than 400 Projects. It will be organized by Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways jointly with FICCI as Industrial Partner and EY as Knowledge Partner.
- 29. For the first time in history, Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has opened its UR Rao Satellite Centre in Bengaluru for testing satellites developed by private sector. Two satellites, developed by Indian startups SpaceKidz India and Pixxel (incorporated as Sygyzy) were tested at UR Rao Satellite Centre.
- 30. Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has launched Mahatma Gandhi National Fellowship (MGNF) during skill partnership function under SANKALP. Fellows under MGNF will acquire academic expertise and technical competency in understanding the overall skill ecosystem along with being attached to District Skill Committees (DSCs). Ministry has partnered with top 9 Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) across India for MGNF implementation.
- **31.NITI** Mission Australia's national Aayog's Atal Innovation (AIM) and science agency (CSIRO) inaugurated India-Australia Circular Economy (I-ACE) Hackathon, 2021, to enable talented innovative students and start-ups from Australia and India to address common national issues through innovative technology solutions. I-ACE is supported by Australian Dept of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources (DISER), AIM Atal Incubation Centre network, and various domain experts.

- 33. The Defence Minister of India, Rajnath Singh, has launched the e-Chhawani portal. With the launch of this portal, the residents of Cantonment areas can now register their complaints with respect to the civic issues.

- 34. The government has shared data that India has suffered a **huge crop loss on 18.176 million hectares of land**. The crop loss on the 18.176 million hectares land amounts to roughly 8.5 per cent of the total gross cropped area. The crop loss occurred due to floods.
- 35. The 18th edition of **BioAsia** event will be held in between February 22, 2021 to February 23, 2021. It will be organised under the theme: 'Move the Needle'. This year, the BioAsia event will focus on Covid-19, pharma, medtech and global health.
- 36. The Union telecom ministry has decided to set up an intelligence unit and a consumer protection system. These systems will be set up in the effort to tackle the threats associated with the pesky calls. It would also help in taking strict action against the financial frauds that happens using telecom resources.
- 37.ISRO and MapmyIndia partners to develop alternative App to Google Map. This indigeniously-developed alternative app will be known as 'Bhuvan' to provide mapping and other location-based services. ISRO's database of satellite images and MapmyIndia's digital map platform will be used to develop new app.
- 38. Defence Minister **Rajnath Singh** has launched an online portal **'e-Chhawani'** and mobile app, to facilitate 'ease of living' and 'ease of doing' for Cantonment Boards residents. **Developed by:** eGov Foundation, Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL), DG Defence Estates and NIC.
- 39. In its first mission in 2021, ISRO will launch Brazilian satellite Amazonia-1 and three Indian payloads by PSLV C-51.
- 40. Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment, **Thaawarchand Gehlot** has virtually released **3rd edition of Indian Sign Language (ISL) Dictionary** with 10,000 terms (including 6,000 earlier terms). **ISL Dictionary** has been brought out by **Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre (ISLRTC)**
- 41. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has launched Pilot Pey Jal Survekshan under Jal Jeevan Mission (Urban). It will be conducted in cities to ascertain equitable distribution of water, reuse of wastewater and mapping of water bodies. It will be initially conducted in 10 cities like Agra, Badlapur, Bhubaneswar, Churu, Kochi, Madurai, Patiala, Rohtak, Surat and Tumkur
- 42. An **IIT Madras**-Incubated start-up **Pi Beam** has recently launched **PiMo**, a sustainable utility **e-bike**. The e-Bike can charge faster than a smartphone and its riding does not require a license or registration.
- 43. The Third **India Tourism Mart** was organised on February 18, 2021. It was addressed by the Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare, Dr Harsh Vardhan. The event was organised by the Federation of Associations in India Tourism and Hospitality (**FAITH**) through video conferencing.
- 44. The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has successfully achieved 100 percent cashless toll collection at the National Highway fee plazas in the entire country. All lanes across the fee plazas on National Highways have been declared as FASTag lanes in effect from February 16, 2021.
- 45. The National Informatics Centre has launched its own instant messaging platform called Sandes on the line of WhatsApp.

- 49.India has joined Iran and Russia in a two-day navy exercise dubbed "Iran-Russia Maritime Security Belt 2021" in the northern part of the Indian Ocean.
- 50.PM Narendra Modi has addressed 6th Governing Council of NITI Aayog focusing on the need of policy framework and cooperation between Centre and state. Meet saw 6 key focus areas: making India a manufacturing powerhouse, reimagining agriculture, improving physical infrastructure, accelerating HRD, improving service delivery at grassroots level and health and nutrition. It was attended by 26 CM, 3 Lt Governors and 2 Administrators, apart from Union Ministers

During the event, the Centre for Creative Learning (CCL), which is based in IIT Gandhinagar, will showcase its 75 toy creations in the fair.

- 56. The Indian Coast Guard Ship (ICG) named as C-453 was commissioned into services in Chennai on February 19. 2021. This was the 17th interceptor boats out of the 18 which are being indigenously built by Larsen & Toubro Ltd.
- 57. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has virtually inaugurated Skill Development Centre (SDC) for Fire Safety Training at Pilkhuwa in Uttar Pradesh. SDC is created by DRDO lab Centre for Fire, Explosive and Environment Safety (CFEES)
- 58. Pune International Centre and Ministry of External Affairs will co-chair Asia Economic Dialogue 2021. The dialogue will be addressed by External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar and his counterparts from Japan, Australia, Maldives, Mauritius and Bhutan.
- 59. The IIT Council, which is the apex decision-making body of IITs has set up four panels for autonomy. The panel will look after several issues ranging from funding to graded autonomy in the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs).
- 60. The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully launched the two indigenously designed and developed Vertical Launch Short Range Surface to Air Missile (VL-SRSAM). The missiles were launched with the help of static vertical launcher. They were launched from Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the Odisha Coast.
- 61. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has inaugurated 26th edition of 'Hunar Haat' in New Delhi. It will be organized with the theme of 'Vocal for Local'. More than 600 artisans and craftsmen from more than 31 states and UTs are participating. Hunar Haat is also available online at hunarhaat.org and on Government e-Marketplace portal for domestic as well as international customers. Hunar Haat is a beautiful exhibition of India's traditional art and craft.
- 62. Mumbai will start the first undersea tunnel of India in 2023 which is being constructed as part of Coastal Road project of Mumbai. Two tunnels will be built under the Mumbai Coastal Road Project. The tunnel will have the length of 2.07 km out of which 1 kilometre portion will be under the sea.
- 63. The International Commission on Large Dams (ICOLD) Symposium on Sustainable Development of Dams & River Basins was inaugurated by the Minister for Jal Shakti, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, on February 24, 2021.
 - The Symposium on Sustainable Development of Dams & River Basins is being organised by the International Commission on Large Dams (INCOLD) in association with the Dam Rehabilitation Improvement Project (DRIP), Central Water Commission (CWC) and National Hydrology Project (NHP).
 - The event will be organized at **New Delhi** as Hybrid event.
 - The event will be participated by more than 300 delegates from India and abroad.
- 64. Indian Coast Guard Ship C-453 has been commissioned at Chennai to join the Coast Guard Eastern fleet. It is the 17th of the 18 Interceptor Boat (IBs) project indigenously constructed by Larsen & Toubro Ltd.
- 65. Kushinagar Airport in Uttar Pradesh has received necessary clearances from aviation regulator DGCA to operate international flights. Once operational, Kushinagar airport will become third functional international facility in UP.
- 66. The ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways informed that the Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the second edition of the Maritime India Summit (MIS) in the virtual mode on March 2, 2021. Apart from that, the ministry has already started signing several Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with various entities.

- 67. The Union Government has announced that the second phase of COVID-19 vaccination will begin from March 1 2021.
- 68. The Central government has notified the new guidelines on social media regulations on February 25, 2021. It is being called as "Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules 2021". The new guidelines have been notified with the aim of regulating social media and OTT platforms.
- 69. The task force on Interlinking of Rivers has approved the Mahanadi-Godavari Link on February 25, 2021. Approval was given to the preparation of final detailed project report on proposed Mahanadi -Godavari link. The linking project was approved by ensuring the utilisation of allocated Godavari waters by the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.
- 70. The Ministry of consumer affairs had decided to integrate the Common Service Centres (CSCs) with the E-Daakhil portal to facilitate the consumers for e-filing. The e-Daakhil Consumer grievance redressal portal was launched on September 7, 2020 by the National Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission. It has been developed and is maintained by National Information Centre (NIC) under MeitY. It is now operational in 15 States and UTs. It has provision of online payment of fees from anywhere.
- 71. The Union education minister, addressed the 16th FICCI Higher Education Summit on February 25, 2021. The summit is being organised in New Delhi from February 25, 2021 to February 27, 2021. While addressing the summit the minister said it will make India the knowledge capital of the world.
- 72. Chief Justice of India S. A. Bobde on February 27, 2021 called for reducing dependence on courts by encouraging parties to opt for pre-litigation mediation which has a way of solving problems, both civil and criminal, which arise from similar dispute. He also inaugurated a new Centenary Building of Patna High Court.
- 73. The India Toy Fair-2021'is being held from February 27 to March 2 in a virtual mode. During the inaugural ceremony, Prime Minister Narendra Modi appealed the toy manufacturers to build toys that are better both for "ecology and psychology." The toy fair is divided into five stages — pre-school to Class II, primary, upper primary, secondary and senior secondary.
- 74. The NITI Aayog and Invest India have associated with the National Bamboo Mission to conduct the National Conference on Opportunities and Challenges for Bamboo in India. The National Conference on Opportunities will be organized with the aim to discuss on the bamboo ecosystem in order to promote holistic growth of the sector across the entire value chain system.

- 80. The Chief Minister of Punjab, Captain Amarinder Singh, has launched the 'Har Ghar Pani, Har Ghar Safai' mission virtually. This mission is the part of the government's campaign to complete the goal of 100 per cent potable piped water supply in all rural households by March 2022.
- 81. The chief minister of **Maharashtra** has launched a scheme to **boost the start-up ecosystem** in Maharashtra. Apart from that, the government has also proposed to set up an international standard Center for the Skill Development in Mumbai. Further, to boost the skill development courses in ITIs are also being updated in a timely manner.
- 82. Uttarakhand sets up first of its kind botanical garden named as 'Shivalik Arboretum' in Nainital for conserving over 210 species of trees found in Shivalik range of Himalayas.
- 83. Andaman and Nicobar Islands has become first Union territory/region to become Covid-19 free in India with active cases falling to zero.

- 84. The health department in Madhya Pradesh has launched the Social Awareness and Action to Neutralise Pneumonia Successfully (SAANS) campaign with the aim of reducing infant mortality due to pneumonia. The state government has also developed training modules in partnership with PGIMER, Chandigarh, and UNICEF.
- 85. Karnataka Government signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with 34 Aerospace and defence firms with an investment prospect of 2464 crore rupees.
- 86. In Jharkhand, the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) wing of the Government of India will cooperate in setting up industries up to 20 crore rupees in Dhanbad. The central government will give 70% amount, while the remaining 30% is to be borne by the state government and industrialists.
- 87.Kerala will open its first Human Milk Bank (HMB) on February 5, 2021. This is a state-of-the-art facility, and Kerala Health Minister KK Shailaja will open at Ernakulam General Hospital. A milk bank was established with the support of the Rotary Club of Cochin Global.
- 88. The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) has approved the creation of the fifth tiger reserve in Tamil Nadu. The tiger reserve will surround the Meghamalai and the Srivilliputhur Grizzled Squirrel Wildlife Sanctuaries within it.
- 89. The Chief Minister of Delhi Arvind Kejriwal launched the 'Switch Delhi' campaign on February 4, 2021. The campaign was launched to promote the use of electric vehicles.
- 90. The third phase of Chah Bagicha Dhan Puraskar mela was held in Guwahati on February 6, 2021. The event was attended by Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. The Assam government will be distributing the financial assistance of 3 thousand rupees to each of 7.5 lakh people who belongs to tea sector.
- 91.India's first thunderstorm research testbed will be established in Balasore, Odisha. The Thunderstorm Research Testbed is being established with the objective to minimalize the human fatalities and loss of property because of the lightning strikes.
- 92. Recently, the Villupuram district administration in Tamil Nadu has issued the first declaration under the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972. The declaration was issued in a bid to declare Kaliveli wetlands as a bird sanctuary.
- 93. Andhra Pradesh has become the second State to implement the power sector reforms that was put forward by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance. The state has implemented the one of the three reforms that was bought in 2020.
- 94. The Central Government has confirmed in a written reply to Lok Sabha about the presence of 1600 tonnes of lithium deposits in Mandya district of Karnataka. However, the significance and the quantity of the lithium in the region can only be confirmed after exploring the entire area.
- 95. Uttar Pradesh government has introduced a system of issuing a unique 16-digit Unicode on February 7, 2020. This Unicode will be used to mark all kinds of landholdings in the state. The Unicode numbers for the land would comprise of the 16 digits.

- 96. PM Narendra Modi has laid the Foundation Stone of two hospitals at Biswanath and Charaideo and launched 'Asom Mala' at Dhekiajuli in Sonitpur District, Assam. Asom Mala: Programme for state highways and major district roads. It is launched in line with 'Bharat Mala Project'.
- 97.India Meteorological Department (IMD) has announced to set up first 'Thunderstorm Research Testbed' of India at Odisha's Balasore district.
- 98. Vijayanagara has been declared as the 31st district of Karnataka through an official gazette notification.
- 99. The office of the Karnataka Digital Economy Mission (KDEM) was inaugurated in Karnataka. The office was inaugurated with the objective of increasing the digital economy contribution to Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) by 30 per cent. Along with the office, the "Beyond Bengaluru" report was also published.
- 100. Maharashtra Small Industries Development Corporation and Maharashtra State Khadi & Village **Industries Board** have signed MoU with **Flipkart** to promote wooden toys, local artifacts, handicrafts.
- 101. The state of Madhya Pradesh has launched a Police Museum at the police headquarters in Bhind, Madhya Pradesh. It is a unique museum themed on the dacoits to showcase their stories. The museum contains several unique items that were used by dacoits namely Phoolan Devi and Nirbhay Gujjar.
- 102.Govt of India, Govt of Chhattisgarh has signed an agreement worth \$100 million with World Bank for project CHIRAAG (Chhattisgarh Inclusive Rural and Accelerated Agriculture Growth). CHIRAAG **Project** will develop sustainable production systems in Chhattisgarh, that will allow tribal households in remote areas to produce diversified and nutritious food, round-the-year.
- 103. Famous 'Mandu Festival' inaugurated at the historic town of Mandu in Dhar district of Madhya Pradesh and will culminate on February 15, 2021.
- 104. Kerala, which is home to India's biggest art event called Kochi-Muziris Biennale, is now aspiring to become a museum hub in the country by setting up mini-museums
- 105. The Chief Minister of Kerala, Pinarayi Vijayan, has inaugurated the first route and terminal buildings of Kochi Water Metro. This project connects the islands across the city with the help of state-of-the-art boats. The metro route ranges from Vyttila to Kakkanad.

- 116. Uttar Pradesh govt has presented biggest ever budget of the state, having total outlay of Rs 5,50,270 crores.

- 131.Indian-American Bhavya Lal has been appointed as Acting Chief of Staff of US space agency National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA). She will also serve as the senior advisor for budget and finance at NASA.
- 132. United States-based Ford Motor Co has partnered with Alphabet Inc's Google to cooperate in software, artificial intelligence, and cloud computing, developing new consumer services.

- 134. The 16th edition of Indo-US joint military exercise 'Yudh Abhyas' will begin in Rajasthan from February 8 and it will be concluded in February 21, 2021. About Yudh Abbhyas 2021 The exercise will be held near the India-Pakistan border.
- 135. Recently, the launch vehicle **Stardust 1.0** was launched from a former military base in US called Loring Commerce Centre. The launch of the vehicle is significant in the light that this is the 1st commercial space launch that is powered by biofuel.
- 136. Pakistan successfully test-fired its nuclear-capable surface-to-surface ballistic missile called Ghaznavi.
- 137. Denmark Govt has approved a project to build the world's first energy island, in the North Sea. It will produce and store enough green energy to meet the electricity needs of three million households in European countries.
- 138. The first India-Bahrain Joint Working Group meeting in the field of Renewable Energy was held in a virtual format on February 04, 2021, for promoting bilateral cooperation in the field of Renewable Energy. The Indian delegation was led by Dinesh Dayanand Jagdale, Joint Secretary, Ministry of New & Renewable Energy. - 140. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has selected SpaceX to launch its SPHEREX Mission. SPHEREx: Spectro-Photometer for the History of the Universe, Epoch of Reionization, and Ices Explorer.
- 141. United Arab Emirates' (UAE) first mission to Mars, Hope Probe has successfully entered the orbit around the red planet.
- 142. Former European Central Bank Chief Mario Draghi has been sworn in as the new Prime Minister of Italy.
- 143. The Prime Minister of Italy, Mario Draghi, has put the climate change at the centre of his plans to run Italy. He has created a **super ministry** to ensure a transition to green energy drives recovery in the country.
- 144.A Chinese spacecraft named Tianwen-1 has successfully entered the orbit around Mars on February 10, 2021. This mission is China's first independent mission on the red planet
- 145. The Nigerian economist Ngozi Okonjo Iweala has been appointed as the head the World Trade Organization. She has become the first woman to take this position. She has also become the first African to hold this charge amid rising protectionism. Okonjo-Iweala was named as the director-general by the representatives of the 164 member countries.

- 152. The International Solar Alliance (ISA) have planned to launch the World Solar Bank (WSB) at the United Nations Climate Change Conference in Glasgow that is scheduled for November 2021. The development of the World Solar Bank will support India's attempt to secure its leadership in the climate arena.
- 153. The Secretary-General of United Nations, Antonio Guterres, has asked the G20 nations to prepare a "Global Covid-19 Vaccination Plan" on February 17, 2020.
- 154. The lower house of French parliament has approved Ant-Radicalism bill in a bid to fight the Islamic radicalism.
- 155. Union Cabinet has approved signing of Comprehensive Economic Cooperation and Partnership Agreement (CECPA) between India and Mauritius. It is the first trade agreement to be signed by India with an African country. Aim: Liberalising norms to boost two-way commerce between the two countries. It will cover Trade in Goods, Rules of Origin, TBT, Dispute Settlement
- 156. India has signed MoU with Nepal's Central Level Project Implementation Unit (Education) for reconstruction of 6 secondary schools.
- 157. United States (US) has officially rejoined Paris Agreement under Presidency of US President Joe Biden.
- 158. **India** signed 5 deals with **Maldives** to boost infrastructure in island nation:
 - Remodel an older EXIM Bank of India Line of Credit of USD 25 million for Road Development
 - Letter of Intent for financing housing project

- 159. India & Ethiopia signed agreements on Visa Facilitation and Leather Technology.
- 160. Israel has launched coronavirus 'green pass' system, that allows people who have been vaccinated to access public facilities.
- 161. The Indian and the Indonesian navies held the PASSEX military exercise in the Arabian sea on February 18, 2021. This military exercise was organised in order to enhance the operational interoperability and the overall cooperation. INS Talwar represented the Indian naval ship. The Indonesian Navy was represented by the multirole corvette KRI Bung Tomo.
- 162. The Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) and the Greenstat Norway signed an agreement to set up the Centre of Excellence on Hydrogen. This agreement was signed some days after India unveiled its national hydrogen mission.

 - Launch coincided with 59th anniversary of America's first orbit around Earth (1962)
- 166. The United States space agency, NASA, released the first audio from Mars. It was a faint crackling recording of the wind that was captured by Perseverance rover. NASA has also released the first video of landing of the rover.
- 167.India and Mauritius have signed a Comprehensive Economic Cooperation and Partnership Agreement (CECPA). This was first ever trade agreement with any African country. It was signed in the presence of Prime Minister of Mauritius, Pravind Jugnauth and the external affairs minister of India, S Jaishankar.

- 168. Japan has appointed the first ever Minister for Loneliness amid the increasing suicide rates in Japan. Suicide rates in Japan has increased for the first time in 11 years in the current COVID-19 pandemic situation.
- 169. The parliament of Australia has passed the landmark legislation called the "News Media and Digital Platforms Mandatory Bargaining Code" on February 25, 2021. This legislation mandates the global digital platforms to pay for publishing the Australian news content on their respective platforms. The legislation mainly targets Facebook and Google.
- 170. The World Trade Organisation (WTO) is under pressure to consider the India's proposal of Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS) waiver on Covid-19 vaccines. Pressure increased on WTO after several European Union lawmakers and group of least developed countries (LDC) provided their support to India's proposal of waiving the TRIPS on vaccines.
- 171. India has started its BRICS Chairship with the inaugural three-day-long Sherpas' meeting on February 25, 2021. The spokesperson of Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), Anurag Srivastava stated that the Secretary (CPV & OIA) chaired the meeting and highlighted the themes, priorities, and calendar for the BRICS 2021. Earlier, the External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar had launched India's BRICS 2021 website at Secretariat of BRICS at Sushma Swarai Bhawan.
- 172.India and Ireland held the bilateral consultations on UN Security Council issues on February 26, 2021 in the virtual mode. During the bilateral consultations, both the countries congratulated each other for their election to United Nation Security Council (UNSC). They also held discussions and briefed each regarding the UNSC priorities.
- 173. The Global anti-terrorism watchdog Financial Action Task Force (FATF) decided to maintain Pakistan into Grey List till June 2021 on February 25, 2021. This decision by the FATF was taken in the light of country's failure to fully comply with the 27-point action plan of to combat the terrorism.
- 174. United Nations Secretary-General António Guterres has announced the appointment of Ligia Noronha of India as Assistant Secretary-General and Head of the New York Office of the United Nations Environment **Programme**. Noronha is an economist and has worked since 2014 as Director of UNEP's Economy Division based in Nairobi, leading UNEP's work on climate mitigation and energy transitions on inclusive green economies, sustainable consumption and production as well as on trade and sustainable finance.
- 175. The Finance Minister of India, Nirmala Sitharaman, attended the G20 Central Bank Governors' meeting on February 26, 2021. This was the first ever G20 Central Bank Governors' meeting that was held under the Italian Presidency.
- 176.India, France, and Australia held trilateral dialogue at the senior officials' level, with focus on further enhancing cooperation in Indo-Pacific.
 - First India-France-Australia Trilateral Dialogue was held virtually on September 9, 2020.
- 177. The new Passenger train service between India and Bangladesh will start on the 26th of March 2021 (Independence Day of Bangladesh).
 - The Haldibari-Chilahati (in Bangladesh) train route was opened after a gap of 55 years for goods trains on the 17th of December last year.

178. UN World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) depicted year 2020 as 'worst year on record' due to highest loss in global tourism due to COVID19. It has been emphasized in latest global travel and tourism report named as 'World Tourism Barometer'. International arrivals in 2020 dropped by -74%. In 2020, overall destinations worldwide welcomed 1 billion fewer international arrivals compared to 2019.

179. According to The Economist Intelligence Unit(EIU), India slipped two places to 53rd position in the 2020 Democracy Index's global ranking. India has been classified as a 'flawed democracy'.

The EIU report uses five criteria - electoral process and pluralism; civil liberties; the functioning of government; political participation; and political culture. A total of 167 countries are ranked.

180. The Business Confidence Index (BCI) was recently published by the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER). 181. The World Bank recently published its report titled "Traffic Crash Injuries and Disabilities: The Burden on Indian Society". This report was released by Union transport minister, Nitin Gadkari, on February 13, 2021. The report mentions the disproportionate impact of a road crash on poor households. It also throws light on the links between poverty, road crashes, inequality and vulnerable road users across India.

- The report highlights that, India has only 1 per cent of the world's vehicles. but it accounts for 11 per cent of the global death due to road accidents. It stands highest death toll in the world because of road accident.
- The world bank report highlighted that the road crash deaths among rural poor households accounts for 44 per cent. While, the road crash death among urban poor households accounts for 11.6 per cent.
- The report further highlights that, the low-income household spends seven months of its income on postroad crash care.
- It also states, a high-income household spends less than a month's salary on the post-road crash care.
- Report reveals that, the socio-economic burden of road crashes is disproportionately borne by poor households.

182. World Bank in association with SaveLife Foundation has prepared report titled as 'Traffic Crash Injuries and **Disabilities: The Burden on Indian Society'** based on 2019 incidents

- Report was released by Union transport minister, Nitin Gadkari.
- As per the report, India has only 1% of world's total vehicles but accounts for 11% of the global death due to road accidents

185. The Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) has released its State of Environment Report, 2021 on February 25, 2021. The report highlighted how the Covid-19 pandemic will impact the children across world.

- The report highlighted that the pandemic will impact the 375 million children across the world. The report highlighted that the pandemic will impact the 375 million children across the world.
- Children including from newborns to 14-year-olds will suffer long-lasting impacts.
- These children will be vulnerable to being underweight, stunting and increased child mortality.
- Their education and work productivity will also be impacted.

The SMAM scheme was launched in the year 2014-15. The scheme was launched by the government of India with the aim of 'reaching the unreached'.
- 191. The second phase of Vigyan Jyoti programme was started on February 11, 221. It was started on the occasion of International Day of Women and Girls in Science. The Vigyan Jyoti Programme will spread the programme to encourage the girls to take interest in science.
- 192. The Union Textile Minister, Smriti Irani, has launched the commercial Jute seed distribution scheme on February 15, 2021. Commercial Jute Seed Distribution Scheme was launched in the backdrop of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the Jute Corporation of India and the National Seeds Corporation.
- 193. The National e-governance plan in agriculture (NeGPA) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The scheme was initially launched in the year 2010-11 in 7 States. Recently, this scheme was extended up to March 31, 2021. The scheme was launched with the aim of achieving the rapid development in India by using Information & Communication.
- 194.Govt of India has launched the PLI scheme for telecommunications and networking products, with an outlay of Rs 12,195 cr over 5 yrs.
 - The scheme will be operational from 1st April 2021.
 - Under the scheme, Telecom manufacturing will be boosted in order to enhance the production of more than Rs 2.4 lakh cr.
 - The scheme also has higher proposed incentives for MSMEs.
 - The PLI scheme was launched in March 2020 in a bid to boost domestic manufacturing.
- 195. The Union Health Minister, Dr Harsh Vardhan, has launched the Intensified Mission Indradhanush (IMI) 3.0.
 - The mission will be conducted in two rounds.
 - The first round will start from February 22, 2021 while the second phase will start from March 22, 2021.
 - It will run across 250 districts or urban areas across the 29 States or Union Territories.
 - Apart from that, the Minister also launched the IMI 3.0 portal and released Operational Guidelines for it.
 - He also launched the awareness material or IEC package developed under the campaign
- 196. The chairman of National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Bhagwan Lal Sahni, said that the NCBC is in favour of four subcategories of the Other Backward Classes (OBCs). This move complies with the recommendation of the Justice Rohini Commission.
 - Justice Rohini Commission was constituted on October 2, 2017. This commission has been appointed in order to study and report about the sub-categorisation of OBCs. The commission will be submitting the report by July 2021.
 - The panel's terms of reference are to study the extent of inequitable distribution of benefits of reservation among castes or communities. The panel will also work out on the mechanism, criteria and parameters for sub-categorisation within the OBCs.

197. The agriculture ministry was allowed to use drones for the purpose of remote sensing data collection under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY). The conditional permission was granted to use the Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) by the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Directorate General of Civil Aviation.

198. The Central government has launched the 'National Urban Digital Mission' on February 23, 2021. The National Urban Digital Mission was launched by the Union Housing & Urban Affairs Minister, Hardeep Singh Puri and Minister of Electronics & IT, Ravi Shankar Prasad.

- While launching the mission, the Union Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry (MoHUA) stated that, this mission will institutionalize the citizen-centric and ecosystem-driven approach for the urban governance and service delivery in cities by the year 2022. It will also be providing these service deliveries in all cities and towns by 2024.
- Initiatives like Smart-Code, India Urban Data Exchange (IUDX), Smart Cities 2.0 website, and Geospatial Management Information System (GMIS) were also launched at this virtual event.
- "India Urban Data Exchange (IUDX)" initiative has been developed by the Smart Cities Mission in partnership with the Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru.

199. The National Institution for Transforming India (NITI Aayog) recently published its draft national policy on migrant labours. The policy was prepared in association with the working subgroup of officials and members of civil society. This draft policy is inspired by the rights-based approach which gain momentum during the return migration.

200. The flagship scheme of the central government, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM KISAN) has completed its two years on February 24, 2021. The PM-KISAN Scheme was formally launched by Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, on February 24, 2019. The scheme was launched at Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh.

201. The Union Cabinet has approved the production-linked Incentive scheme for IT Hardware on February 24, 2021.

- The PLI scheme proposes an incentive to boost the domestic manufacturing.
- It also proposes to attract large investments in value chain of IT Hardware.
- The proposed scheme includes the target segments like tablets, laptops, all-in-one PCs and servers.
- Total cost of the proposed scheme is around Rs.7,350 crore for 4 years.
- The budget includes an incentive outlay of Rs.7,325 crore besides the administrative charges of Rs 25 crore.
- Under the scheme, a total production of worth Rs 3,26,00 crore will be achieved out of which 75 per cent will be achieved through the exports.
- This scheme has a potential to generate direct and indirect employment of over 1,80,000 in over 4 years.
- It will provide also provide impetus to Domestic Value Addition for IT Hardware for which there is an expectation that it will rise to 20% - 25% by 2025.

202. Union Cabinet has also approved Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Pharmaceuticals from 2020-21 to 2028-29

• It will benefit domestic manufacturers and is expected to provide wide range of affordable medicines for consumers.

- Under this, total incremental sales of Rs 2,94,000 crore and total incremental exports of Rs 1,96,000 crore are estimated from 2022-23 to 2027-28.
- It is also expected to **generate employment** for both skilled and unskilled personnel.

203. Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation (Ministry of Jal Shakti) has announced the selection of 12 iconic sites under Phase IV of Swachh Iconic Places.

- These sites include Ajanta Caves (Maharashtra), Sanchi Stupa (Madhya Pradesh), Kumbhalgarh Fort, Jaisalmer Fort & Ramdevra (Rajasthan), Golconda Fort (Telangana) and Konark Sun Temple (Odisha).
- Rock Garden, Dal Lake, Banke Bihari Temple (Mathura), Agra Fort (Uttar Pradesh) and Kalighat Temple (West Bengal).

ECONOMY & BUSINESS

204. The Finance Minister of India, Nirmala Sitharaman, announced an Agricultural Infrastructure And Development Cess (AIDC) on some goods while presenting Union Budget 2021. AIDC was announced to provide support to those sector that has been one bright spot amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

205. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman highlighted, while presenting the union budget for 2021-2022, that the fiscal deficit for the financial year 2021-22 is estimated as 6.8 percent of the gross domestic product (GDP). The finance minister highlighted that the fiscal deficit is estimated to increase up to 9.5% in the Financial Year 2020-21.

206. The commerce ministry is organising the Udyog Manthan. Under the Udyog Manthan, a series of webinars are being conducted. The Webinar is focusing on about 45 sectors including the pharma sector and electronics sector. The webinar under the Udyog Manthan is being organised with the focus on quality and productivity.

207. The ministry of corporate affairs (MCA) has amended definition of the small companies by amending the Companies Rules. The new amendment allows the non-resident Indians (NRIs) to incorporate one person companies (OPCs) in India. The changes were announced by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman during the presentation of Union budget.

208. In the last bi-monthly monetary policy meet for the current, the Reserve Bank of India projected India's GDP growth rate at 10.5 per cent for the fiscal year 2021-22. The growth outlook has improved significantly, and the vaccination drive will further boost the economic rebound.

The apex bank expects the Indian economy to grow in the range of 8.3 per cent to 26.2 per cent in the first half of FY22, followed by a 6 per cent growth in Q3FY22. The central bank's projection is lower than that of the Economic Survey that projected India to grow at a rate of 11 per cent in the coming fiscal.

209. Recently, the Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) stated that a panel of Ministers would take final decision regarding the number of public sector companies that will be retained in each of the strategic sectors. The panel of ministers will comprise of Nirmala Sitharaman, the Finance Minister and Nitin Gadkari, the Road Transport.

- 210. The California-based global digital payment platform PayPal has announced that the company has decided to wind down its domestic payment services in India with effect from April 01, 2021. The decision has been taken because the company wants to shift its focus on cross-border payments business.
- 211. Reliance Industries Ltd has received the world's first consignment of 'carbon-neutral oil' from Oxy Low Carbon Ventures (OLCV), a division of United State oil major Occidental.
- 212. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) will launch the data analytics-driven MCA21 Version 3.0 by October 2021 in the financial year 2021-22. The MCA21 Version 3.0 system is the Mission Mode e-Governance project of India. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs highlights that the project will comprise of the additional modules for e-Adjudication, e-Consultation, and Compliance Management.
- 213. The Rating agency Moody's have recently forecasted that the nominal Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of India will rise closer to 17% in the Financial Year 2021.
- 214. State Bank of India's Economic Research Department has revised India's FY21 GDP estimates to (-) 7.0%. Prior to this, SBI had estimated FY21 GDP at -7.4%.
- 215. The Tata Electronics has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Tamil Nadu government in order to establish a facility to manufacture the mobile components.
- 216.ACC Ready Mix Concrete has recently introduced its new low carbon range of concrete called ECOPact. It is a "Green Concrete" that has been introduced for a high-performing, sustainable and circular construction. ECOPact was launched in Mumbai and Hyderabad in the first phase.
- 217. The **Tata Electronics** has signed a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** with the Tamil Nadu government in order to establish a facility to manufacture the mobile components.
 - The project by the Tata Electronics will cost Rs 4684 crores. It will be established in Krishnagiri to manufacture the mechanical enclosures of mobile phones.
- 218. Govt has increased budget of Dept of Science and Technology and Ministry of Earth Sciences by 30% as compared to the revised estimate of 2020-21.
- 219. The Reserve Bank of India has approved the takeover of Dewan Housing Finance Corporation Ltd (DHFL) by Piramal Group on February 18, 2021.
- 220. E-commerce giant Amazon has announced plans to begin manufacturing devices in India. This is the first Amazon manufacturing line in India and reiterates the firm's commitment to the government's Make in India for an Aatmanirbhar Bharat. Amazon will commence manufacturing with contract manufacturer Cloud Network Technology, a subsidiary of Foxconn, in Chennai, and start production later this year. It will churn out hundreds of thousands of Fire TV Stick devices every year.
- 221. Hyundai Motors has launched Transformer-like robocar named as 'TIGER X-1', that can travel over the most challenging terrains on the Earth as well as on other planets. TIGER: Transforming Intelligent Ground Excursion Robot.
- 222.MSME Minister Nitin Gadkari has inaugurated 50 artisan-based SFURTI clusters spread over 18 States.

- These clusters will have over 42 thousand artisans belonging to traditional segments of muslin, khadi, coir, handicraft, handlooms, wood craft, leather, pottery, etc
- These clusters have been inaugurated in Andhra Pradesh, ArunachaL, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, MP, Maharashtra, Manipur, Nagaland, Odisha, Rajasthan, TN, UP and WB

223.S&P Global Ratings has forecasted that India will be one of the fastest growing emerging market economies with 10% growth in the next fiscal, during webinar on India outlook for 2021.

- **India's economy** has stabilized over recent months, with progressively better manufacturing, services, labour market, and revenue data.
- S&P Global Ratings Headquarters: New York, United States.
- 224. China has again become India's top trading partner in the year 2020. The reason was that India was still dependent on the import of heavy machines, telecom equipment and home appliances from China.
 - The provisional data from the trade between both the countries in the year 2020 stood at \$77.7 billion.
 - However, the trade had decreased as compared to the 2019 trade total of \$85.5 billion.
 - The imports of heavy machines etc outweighed India's efforts to cut down its dependence on trade.
 - As a result of which, the bilateral trade gap of India with China was \$40 billion in the year 2020.
 - Total imports from China stood at \$58.7 billion which was more that India's combined imports from U.S. and U.A.E.
 - The data further highlights that, India was able to lower the imports from its Asian neighbors despite there were demand disruptions amid the coronavirus pandemic.

225.India's External Affairs Minister has signed Free Trade Agreement (FTA) or Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Partnership Agreement-(CECPA) with Mauritius

- FTA is India's first pact with any African country and will help Mauritius to emerge as a hub of Africa
- India has also offered a USD 100 million Line of Credit (LoC) to Mauritius to facilitate procurement of defence assets.

226. The Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) and the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) have signed an MoU to promote the Export-Oriented Marine Product. The MoU was signed in order to synergise the programmes related to export-oriented capture and culture in fisheries sectors and other allied sectors.

227. The Defence Acquisition Council (**DAC**) has approved the acquisition of **118 Arjun Mark 1A tanks** on February 23, 2021. The approval was given for the Indian Army at a cost of ₹6,000 crores. This move will be a boost for the indigenisation in defence sector.

228. The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has set up the working group committee so as to relook its **information and security guidelines**. The need to set up the panel was felt in the aftermath of exponential increase in cyberattacks across the world amid the ongoing covid-19 pandemic.

229. The National Statistical Office (NSO) recently released its data on the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the financial year 2021. As per the NSO, the Indian economy will be **expanded by 0.4% in the December quarter.**

- 230. ICRA has projected the Indian economy to contract 7% in current fiscal (FY21). For the next fiscal, i.e. FY22 (2021-22), ICRA expects a considerable rebound in India's economic growth to 10.5% due to higher central government spending, and a pick-up in consumption.
 - ICRA (Investment Information and Credit Rating Agency of India Ltd) is an Indian independent and professional investment information and credit rating agency
 - Headquarters: Gurugram, India.
- 231. Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) has signed MoU with MOL (Asia Oceania) for transportation of Liquefied Natural Gas through barges on National Waterways-1 and National Waterways-2
 - IWAI will provide support for, facilitating with adequate fairway, handling of LPG cargo on IWAI terminals or Multimodal Terminals at Haldia, Sahibgani and Varanasi.
- 232. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has launched The City Innovation Exchange (CiX) platform.
 - The platform will be a significant addition to the growing innovation ecosystem of India and focuses on fostering innovative practices in cities.
 - The CiX will connect cities to innovators across the national ecosystem to design innovative solutions for their pressing challenges.
 - The Platform has more than **400 start-ups**, 100 smart cities, more than **150 challenges** statements.
- 233. Khadi and Village Industry Commission's e-Market Portal has registered a gross turnover of over Rs. one crore 10 lakh in just eight months of its launch.
 - This portal has provided a wide marketing platform for various Khadi and village industry products to a larger population.
 - Online orders have been received from all 31 States and UT including the far-flung Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Kerala, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir among others.

- 234. Bharti AXA General Insurance has launched 'Krishi Sakha' app to help farmers in adopting best farming practices, enhancing productivity by catering to specific needs of farmers.
- 235.Govt has increased FDI limit from 49 to 74% in Insurance Companies and allowed foreign ownership and control with safeguards. Under this, majority of Directors on Board and key management persons would be resident Indians, with at least 50% of Directors being Independent Directors, and specified percentage of profits.
- 236. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on has introduced a Risk-Based Internal Audit (RBIA) system. It has made it mandatory for select non-banking financial companies and urban co-operative banks (UCBs). As per the norms, all the deposit-taking non-banking financial companies (NBFCs) with the asset size of Rs 5,000 crore will have to implement this system. Also, the UCBs having asset size of Rs 500 crore will have to implement the system. The system is required to be implemented by March 31, 2022. The performance of the RBIA system will be looked by the

board of the entity or its audit committee. The board of the entity is already responsible to look after the internal audit function of the organisation.

- 237.GoI has announced introduction of unified securities markets code in Budget 2021-22, boosting ease of doing business in India's financial markets. Under this, provisions of SEBI Act, 1992, Depositories Act, 1996, Securities Contracts (Regulation) Act, 1956 and Government Securities Act, 2007 will be consolidated into rationalized single Securities Markets Code. Govt will also support Fin-Tech hub development at GIFT-IFSC and frame Permanent institutional framework.
- 238. Union Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman while presenting Union Budget FY 2021-22 has approved policy of strategic disinvestment of public sector enterprises. It consists of 2-fold sectors:
 - Strategic Sector: to be privatised or merged or subsidiarized with other CPSEs or closed. Ex: Atomic energy, Space and Defence, Transport, Banking, Insurance and financial services
 - Non-Strategic Sector: In this sector, CPSEs will be privatised, otherwise shall be closed
- 239. Govt has extended eligibility for claiming tax holiday for start-ups by 1 more year till 31stof March 2022 to incentivise start-ups in the country. Govt has also extended capital gains exemption for investment in start-ups by one more year to incentivise funding of the start-ups.
- 240. Govt has proposed to infuse Rs 20,000 crore to re-capitalized Public Sector Banks.
- 241. Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has amended One Person Companies (OPCs) rules with effect from April 2021 to benefits Startups & Innovators in the country. Previously NRIs were not allowed to incorporate OPCs. Now any natural person, who is an Indian citizen, whether resident in India or otherwise would be allowed to form an OPC. For being considered as a resident in India, residency period has been proposed to be reduced to 120 days from 182 days for NRIs.
- 242.RBI has announced to set up of 24*7 helpline for digital payment services, integrated ombudsman scheme, CTS across all bank branches and allowing retail investors to open Gilt accounts with RBI. The major payment system operators will give information on available grievance redress mechanisms by September 2021. RBI will provide retail investors online access to the government securities market along with the facility to open their gilt securities account with the RBI.
- 243. Federal Bank has announced the launch of "FedFirst", a special savings account scheme for children below 18 vears of age. The account helps children develop healthy saving and spending habits, thereby giving them the freedom to save, spend and earn.
- 244. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will set up an expert committee on Urban Co-operative Banks (UCBs). The committee, involving all stakeholders, will provide a medium-term road map for strengthening the sector, enable faster resolution/rehabilitation of UCBs.
- 245. The six-member Monetary Policy Committee of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), headed by Governor Shaktikanta Das, has decided to maintain the status quo on policy rate amid sticky rate of inflation. At this point, the repo rate or the rate at which RBI lends to banks stands unchanged at 4 per cent. The reverse repo rate also stayed unchanged at 3.35 per cent. The MPC committee members voted unanimously in favour of the decision.
- 246. The key decisions taken in the Monetary Policy Committee meeting are:
 - Policy Repo Rate: 4.00%

• Marginal Standing Facility Rate: 4.25%

• Bank Rate: 4.25%

• CRR: 3% • SLR: 18.00%

RBI Monetary Policy Highlights & Key Decisions:

- The MPC continued to maintain the accommodative stance.
- The MPC has predicted the economic growth rate i.e. GDP growth rate of India at 10.5 per cent in 2021-22 (FY22).
- This is the first MPC meeting after the presentation of the Union Budget 2021-22.
- The six-member MPC headed by RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das meets every two months to analyze the state of the Indian economy and inflation and address the monetary issues in the country.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced that it will integrate the consumer grievances redressal under a single ombudsman as opposed to the three grievance redressal schemes working at present. RBI will adopt the 'One Nation One Ombudsman' approach to make the alternate dispute redress mechanism simple and more responsive to the users.
- The mechanism will cater to all the customers from banks, NBFCs and the non-bank issuers of prepaid payment instruments.
- The e-Integrated Ombudsman Scheme will be rolled out in June 2021.

247.RBI has released Annual Report of the Ombudsman Schemes for the year 2019-20 that depicts an increase of 65% in receipt of complaints out of which almost 92% have been disposed of.

- RBI has 3 Ombudsmen that can be approached for grievances:
- Banking (ATM & Debit Cards, Electronic Banking complaints)
- NBFC (non-observance of regulatory guidelines, lack of transparency/ loan agreement and levy of charges without notice complaints)
- **Digital transactions** (fund transfer)

248. The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has announced to launch 'NPCI PayAuth Challenge'. It is a global-level hackathon that will be organised to get the alternatives of the authentication of Unified Payments Interface (UPI) transactions. One such alternative options is the use of biometric while making transactions.

249. The Finance Ministry has decided to infuse Rs 3,000 crore capital into the state-owned general insurance companies in the fourth quarter of FY 2020-21.

250. Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has launched Financial Literacy Week (FLW) from Feb 8 to 12, 2021 to propagate financial education on a particular theme across the country.

- FLW theme 2021: Credit Discipline and Credit from Formal Institutions
- FLW theme is one of the strategic objectives of National Strategy for Financial Education 2020-2025
- Focus will be on responsible borrowing, borrowing from formal institution and timely repayments

251. The Reserve Bank of India has announced that the Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank) will provide USD 400 million to Maldives project. Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank) will provide \$400 million to Maldives through Line of Credit (LoC) to fund Greater Male Connectivity Project (GMCP) with effect from Jan 28, 2021.

252. Private general insurer ICICI Lombard has launched the 'Corporate India Risk Index'. This is intended to be a unified, standardised corporate risk index that spans industries and companies. This will help companies understand the level of risk that their business is facing and also assist in developing a successful risk aversion plan.

253. The New Development Bank (NDB) has announced to invest \$100 million into the NIIF Fund of Funds (FoF). With the NDB's investment of \$100 million, the NIIF FoF has now secured \$800 million in commitments. NDB has joined the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), Government of India (GoI) and Asian Development Bank (ADB) as an investor in the NIIF FoF.

254. The Reserve Bank of India (**RBI**) has recently released its data on the Bank Credit and Deposits. The data shows that, the Bank credit grew by **5.93 per cent** which now accounts for Rupees 5 lakh crore for the fortnight that ended January 29, 2021.

- It also highlights that, the deposits in the banks have rose by 11.06 per cent that accounts for Rupees 98 lakh crore for the same period.
- Thus, in the fortnight that ended January 31, 2020, the bank credit stands at ₹05 lakh crore while the deposits stand at Rupees 133.24 lakh crore.
- The RBI data further shows that, during the first nine months of the fiscal year 2020-2021, the bank credit increased by 3.2 percent while the deposits increased by 8.5 per cent.
- The data highlights that, the non-food credit growth of banks was 5.9 per cent in December 2020.
- It also highlights that, the growth in the credit to agriculture and allied activities has increased to 9.4 per cent as compared to 5.3 per cent growth in December 2019.
- Loans to industry have decreased by 1.2 per cent because of contraction in the credit to large industries by 2.4 per cent.
- Further, the Personal loans decreased by 9.5 per cent in the current financial year (2020-2021).

255. RBI has constituted 8-member expert committee on Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks (UCBs) to examine issues, suggesting a road map for strengthening it.

- Chairperson: N. S. Vishwanathan (RBI Deputy Governor)
- It will also review current regulatory approach and recommend suitable measures.
- It suggests effective measures for faster resolution of UCBs.

256. ICICI Lombard and Frost & Sullivan has launched unified, standardised index that spans industries and companies named as Corporate India Risk Index.

- It will help companies understand the level of risk that their business is facing and also assist in developing a successful risk aversion plan
- Index consists of 15 sectors including IT, automotive, pharma, etc covering 150 top companies, 2 risk elements across 6 broad dimensions.

257. To facilitate the privatization of **PSU banks**, govt is likely to bring amendments to **2 Acts**.

- The two laws to be amended are Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act, 1970 and the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act, 1980.
- The four banks to be privatized are Bank of Maharashtra, Bank of India, Indian Overseas Bank and the Central Bank of India.

258. Flipkart has partnered with ICICI Lombard to offer its customers group health insurance policy named as 'Group SafeGuard' insurance.

- 259. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has brought the State Bank of Sikkim under its regulation. State Bank of Sikkim It is a state-owned banking institution. The headquarter of the bank is at Gangtok, Sikkim. It operates under the jurisdiction of the State of Sikkim.
- 260. The finance ministry has allowed all the private sector banks to participate in business related to government such as small savings schemes and collection of taxes pension payments. Currently, only some of the big private sectors are allowed to conduct government-related businesses.
- 261. The Finance Ministry has announced that, the Central government has signed a loan agreement with the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) for the Assam Power Transmission Project. The loan agreement was signed worth \$304 million. This loan will be used for strengthening electricity transmission system in the state of Assam.
- 262. The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDAI) has launched a standard personal accident cover called Saral Suraksha Bima. This accident cover will be mandatorily offered by the general and health insurers from April 1, 2021. This product has assured maximum sum of Rs 1 crore while the minimum assured sum of Rs 2.5 lakh.
- 263. Report on Currency and Finance (RCF) by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) official has recommended that, the time span that was considered to measure whether monetary policy-setting panel has failed in achieving its objectives or not should be of four quarters rather than current time period of three-quarter.
 - The report also recommends that roll the terms for the members in six-member Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) in order to moderate the political influence at the place of current appointments for the fixed term.
 - Report highlights that, the definition for failure of MPC needs to be revised from the present threequarter horizon.
 - According to the report, the failure can be redefined as inflation overshooting or inflation undershooting the upper and lower tolerance bands around the set target for time span of four consecutive quarters.
 - Report emphasised that, there should be a greater flexibility for monetary policy and MPC in order to go through sharp movements in food prices which are brought about by transient factors.
 - The report further states that, the definition of failure that balances two objectives will help in preventing the volatility in the output growth which is brought by the policy responses.
- 264. The Central Board of Direct Taxes has extended the last date for availing of the direct tax Vivaad Se Vishwas dispute resolution scheme to March 31, 2021.
 - This is the fifth extension of the scheme. Those willing to settle their tax disputes under the Direct Tax Vivad Se Vishwas Act can file their declarations till March 31 and pay the settled tax amount by April 30, 202.
- 265. Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) signed MoU with Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) for exchange of data for enhancing ease of doing business in India and improve overall regulatory enforcement.
