- 1. Samsung Electronics set up Samsung innovation lab at Delhi Technological University (DTU) to promote joint research and training on domains such as artificial intelligence, machine learning and computer vision.
- 2. Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare Harsh Vardhan has been appointed as the Chairman of 'Stop TB Partnership Board' with effect from July 2021.
  - He will be serving at this post for 3-year tenure.
- 3. IT major Amazon Web Services and NITI Aayog partnered to train students on the fundamentals of cloud computing through Atal Tinkering Labs.
  - AWS will introduce the fundamentals of cloud computing to students at more than 7,000 ATLs.
- 4. Union Health Minister, Harsh Vardhan has inaugurated Advanced High Resolution Microscopy Facility at National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute (NABI) and Unveiled the 4 Star GRIHA Certification of Center of Innovative and Applied Bioprocessing (CIAB) Lab and Admin Building at Mohali, Punjab

### STATES AFFAIRS

- 5. The Mission Gramodaya has been launched in Madhya Pradesh.
  - Under the Gramodaya mission, besides providing housing facilities in rural areas, basic and fundamental infrastructure will also be expanded.
- 6. The Jharkhand govt launched the SAAMAR (Strategic Action for Alleviation of Malnutrition and **Anemia Reduction)** campaign to tackle malnutrition.
- 7. Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot announced to launch of the much anticipated **Universal Health** Scheme (UHS) "Mukhya Mantri Chiranjeevi Yojana".

### INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

8. Italy has signed amended Framework Agreement of International Solar Alliance (ISA) with India

- The amendments to the **ISA Framework agreement** entered into force in Jan 8, 2021, opening its membership to all Member States of the UN, including those lying beyond the tropics.
- 9. **Ajay Mathur** has assumed the charge as the **Director General of International Solar Alliance (ISA)** with effect from March 15, 2021.
  - He has been appointed for tenure of 4 years which can be renewed for an additional term.
- 10. **Singapore** is building **world's largest floating solar farms of the world** to support the effort against climate change
  - It will be **60 mw-peak floating solar system** with 1200 panels and is being built at **Tengeh Reservoir** by Sembcorp Industries in collaboration with Singapore Public Utilities Board

#### **REPORTS & INDICES**

- 11. **Hurun India Wealth Report 2020** has been released. According, to the report, there are **412,000 dollar-millionaire households/affluent households** in India with net worth of Rs 7 crore.
  - Top 10 states that are home to 70.3% of millionaire households in India: **Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka** and **Gujarat.**
- 12. **New Delhi** has been ranked as the **10th most polluted city** in World's **most polluted capital city** for 3rd straight year, in **2020 World Air Quality Report** by Swiss organisation, **IQAir** 
  - Top most polluted city of the world: Xinjiang, China
- 13. Sweden-based Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) released report titled 'Trends in International Arms Transfers-2020'
  - As per the report, **imports of weapons and military equipment of India declined by 33%** during 2016-2020
  - India continues to be 2nd largest World importer, despite import rates cut
  - Largest arms importers: Saudi Arabia, India, Egypt, Australia, China
  - Largest arms exporters: US, Russia, France, Germany, China. India ranked 24th in this
- 14. UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network has released the World Happiness Report 2021.
  - Finland was once again crowned as the world's happiest country.
  - India has been ranked 139 out of 149 countries.
  - **Denmark** ranked 2nd followed by **Switzerland**, **Iceland** and the **Netherlands**.
  - **Afghanistan** was classed as the world's unhappiest nation this year.
- 15. UN Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) has projected India's economy contraction by 6.9% in 2020 due to coronavirus pandemic.

### **GOVERNMENT SCHEMES & PROGRAMMES**

- 16. Convergence Energy Services Ltd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Energy Efficiency Services Ltd (EESL), unveiled the GRAM UJALA programme.
  - Under the programme, high-quality energy-efficient **LED bulbs** will be given for **Rs 10 per piece** in certain villages of five states in the first phase.
  - The programme will be financed entirely through carbon credits and will be the first such programme in India.
  - In phase-I of the programme, 15 million LED bulbs will be distributed
- 17. PM Narendra Modi has launched 'Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain' campaign on World Water Day (22nd March)
  - Campaign will run till 30th Nov, 2021
  - It will be undertaken across the country, in 734 districts covering 600,000 villages with theme 'catch the rain, where it falls, when it falls'
  - It will be launched as Jan Andolan to take water conservation at grass-root level through people's participation. During this, geotagging of all water bodies will be carried out.
- 18. Union Environment Minister, **Prakash Javadekar** has launched new **Nagar Van Scheme** for creation of Urban forests in the cities on the occasion of International Day of Forests
  - Under Nagar Van Scheme, Urban forests will be developed in 200 cities in its first phase.
  - **Drone mapping water conservation** and tree plantation were also taken into consideration.

### **ECONOMY & BUSINESS**

- 19. United States (US) has overtaken Saudi Arabia as India's second biggest oil supplier.
  - Oil import of India from US rose 48% to a record 545,300 barrels per day (bpd) in Feb 2021 compared to Jan 2021
- 20. Govt has constituted an experts advisory committee for overall execution and monitoring of Startup **India Seed Fund Scheme** 
  - H K Mittal (Dept of Science and Technology) will head the committee
  - Apart from this, members from DPIIT, dept of biotechnology, science and technology, electronics and IT, Niti Aayog, startup ecosystem will be part of it

- It will enable finance investments by small and medium enterprises (SMEs) of India in renewable energy solutions including rooftop solar installations
- These loans will enable SMEs to access reliable power and will cut the cost.
- 22. Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) projected Indian economy is expected to grow 12.6% in FY22.
- 23. Moody's Analytics had projected the Indian economy to grow 13.7% in FY22.

### FINANCE & BANKING

- 24. National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has launched 'UPI-Help' on BHIM UPI for grievance redressal mechanism for the users of the BHIM application
- 25. India's foreign-exchange reserves become the world's fourth largest reserve the world, surpassing Russia.
  - Foreign currency holdings of India fell by \$4.3 billion to \$580.3 billion, as per the data by Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- 26. Union Cabinet has approved creation of **Pradhan** Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Nidhi (PMSSN) under Section 136-b of Finance Act, 2007
  - It is a single non-lapsable reserve fund for health from the proceeds of health and Education cess.
  - Share of Health from the proceeds of **Health and Education Cess (4%)** will be credited to **PMSSN**
- 27. RBI has decided to extend new Cheque Truncation System (CTS) across all bank branches in India by September 30, 2021.
  - It is issued under Section 10 (2) and Section 18 of Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007 (Act 51 of 2007).
- 28. **RBI** has imposed a **monetary penalty of ₹2 Crore on State Bank of India** for contravention of provisions of section 10 (1) (b) (ii) of Banking Regulation Act, 1949 and payment of remuneration to employees in the form of commission.

- 29. RBI has released data related to 2019-20 round of its annual survey on exports of computer software and IT enabled services
  - Survey collects details on India's exports of software services as per type of activity, on-site/off-site nature of service, country of destination and modes of supply
  - India's export of software services stood at US\$ 128.6 billion during 2019-20, registering 9.1% growth
  - Exports of computer services and ITES/BPO services contributed 66.6% and 33.4 %
- 30. Union Cabinet has approved bill to set up Development Finance Institution (DFI) with an initial capital infusion of Rs 20 thousand crores.

#### **AWARDS & RECOGNISTION**

- 31. Sahitya Akademi has announced annual literary honour in India, Sahitya Akademi Awards 2020 in 20 Indian languages.
  - The awards include 7 books of poetry, 4 novel, 5 short stories, 2 plays, and one each of memoirs and epic poetry.

32. Arindam Bagchi took charges as the official spokesperson of Union Ministry of External Affairs (MEA).

33. Veteran Kathakali artist **Chemancheri Kunhiraman Nair (105 years)** passed away in Kozhikode, Kerala due to old age-related ailments.

- 36. International Day of Forests (World Forestry Day) is observed every year on March 21 to commemorate and raise awareness of the significance of all types of forests
  - UN General Assembly adopted International Day of Forests on November 28, 2012
  - Theme 2021: Forest restoration: a path to recovery and well-being
- 37. World Water Day (WWD) is observed every year on 22nd March to highlight the importance and sustainable management of fresh water.
  - UN-Water is the convener for World Water Day.
  - Theme of WWD 2021: Valuing Water.

### **SPORTS**

- 38. Youth Affairs & Sports Minister Kiren Rijiju has announced to set up Winter Sports Institute in Gulmarg, Kashmir.
  - He also announced inauguration of 100 small sports centres under Khelo India mission.
- 39. Tamil Nadu's Chadalavada Anandha Bhavani Devi (27 years) became the first-ever fencer from India to quality for Olympic Games.
  - She secured a spot for the Tokyo Olympics at the World Cup in Hungary.
- 40. Indian athlete Avinash Sable set a new national record in men's 3000m steeplechase event in ongoing Federation Cup Senior National Athletics Championships in Patiala with 8:20.20 timing.
