- 1. The Union Minister for Information & Broadcasting said that the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting is associating with IIT Bombay to form a Centre of Excellence in gaming and other related areas.
- 2. Ministry of Culture has organized 3rd and final edition of Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav 2021 at Murshidabad, West Bengal.
  - Directors of all zonal cultural centres of Ministry of Culture were present during inauguration of Mahotsav and lit the ceremonial lamp.
- 3. The Union Minister of **Health & Family Welfare** and Science & Technology, Dr. Harsh Vardhan, inaugurated the second edition of **Global-Bio India-2021** on March 1, 2021. This is a three-day event which will be organised from March 1 to March 3, 2021 under the Theme- 'Transforming Lives' along with the tagline 'Biosciences to Bio-economy'.
- 4. The National Association of Software and Service Companies (NASSCOM) is all set to launch its 'Al Game Changers' program in India.
  - The programme will be launched to promote the artificial intelligence (AI)-led innovation across the country.
  - The programme is being run in collaboration with the innovation partner for the programme, Microsoft.
- 5. PM Narendra Modi has inaugurated **Maritime India Summit-2021** through video conferencing.
  - It is organized by Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways on a virtual platform www.maritimeindiasummit.in.
  - It will visualize a roadmap for India's Maritime sector for next decade.
  - **Denmark** is the partner country for the three-day summit.
- 6. India has launched the "Real-time Vessel Tracking System" in order to help the seafarers and fishermen as and when they need. This system has been named as "Sagar-Manthan: Mercantile Marine Domain Awareness Centre (MMDAC)".
  - The system was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the Maritime India Summit-2021.

  - Aim: to bring rural women Self Help Groups (SHGs) under one platform to show-case their skills
- 8. **CERAWeek Conference-2021** has been organized from **March 1 to 5, 2021** by **IHS Markit** based in Houston, Texas
  - Theme: The New Map: Energy, Climate, and Charting the Future
  - It is an annual international energy conference of energy industry leaders, experts, government officials and policymaker
  - During this, PM Modi will receive CERAWeek Global Energy and Environment Leadership Award
- 9. Minister for Social justice and Empowerment Thaawarchand Gehlot will virtually launch 'Sugamya Bharat App'.
  - Sugamya Bharat App: Means for sensitising and enhancing accessibility. It provides for registration of complaints of inaccessibility, transportation sector and ICT ecosystem.
- 10. Rajya Sabha TV and Lok Sabha TV have been merged and now the new merged channel will be known as Sansad TV.
  - Sansad TV: It will telecast live proceedings of both Upper and Lower Houses on two different channels during simultaneous sitting of the Houses.
- 11. Union Education Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal has virtually inaugurated New Delhi World Book Fair 2021-Virtual Edition.
  - It has been organized by National Book Trust (NBT).
  - Theme of 2021 New Delhi World Book Fair: 'National Education Policy-2020'.

- 12. DRDO has conducted successful flight test of Solid Fuel Ducted Ramjet (SFDR) technology from integrated test range (ITR), Chandipur, off Odisha coast
  - SFDR is a missile propulsion system being developed primarily by **Defence Research and Development Laboratory (DRDL)** and **Research Centre Imarat (RCI)** in Hyderabad.
  - 13. PM Modi will inaugurate 'Maitri Setu' between India and Bangladesh
    - It has been built over **Feni river** which flows between Tripura and Bangladesh
    - It has been built by National Highways and Infrastructure Development
  - 14. Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways Mansukh Mandaviya has flagged off an all-woman crew onboard Shipping Corporation of India (SCI) vessel, MT Swarna Krishna.
  - 15. Minister of Culture and Tourism Prahlad Singh Patel has inaugurated All-Women's Art Exhibition titled as 'Akshya Patra' at Rabindra Bhavan Galleries in New Delhi on the occasion of International Women's Day.
    - The exhibition has been curated by Lalit Kala Akademi for providing opportunity to all the female artists around India and the world.

- 16. Union Minister, Sanjay Dhotre has inaugurated International Conference on Multifunctional **Electronic Materials and Processing (MEMP 2021)** virtually on the occasion of 30th foundation day of Centre for Materials for Electronics Technology.
  - It is organised by Centre for Materials for Electronics Technology (C-MET), Pune from 8 to 10 March 2021.
- 17. Union Ministry of Women and Child Development (WCD) has signed an agreement with Invest India in New Delhi to enhance cooperation.
  - The aim will enhance co-operation in the thematic areas of Nutrition, Child Protection and **Development, Women Empowerment** and convergent capacity building in mission mode.

- 18. **DRISHTI** under **Invest India** will conduct input and output analysis research, and other research as per requirement including coordinating with research agencies.
- 19. Third Scorpene-class submarine 'INS Karanj' was commissioned into Indian Navy in Mumbai
  - It is third in the series of six Scorpene-class diesel-electric submarine, being built for Indian Navy
  - It has been designed by France's Naval Group and is being built in India by Mazagon Dock Limited under Project 75.
- 20. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has launched indigenously made sounding rocket, RH-**560** from Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota Range, Andhra Pradesh
  - RH-560 will study attitudinal variations in neutral winds and plasma dynamics
- 21. PM Narendra Modi has virtually addressed 4th Global Ayurveda Festival (GAF) in Kozhikode
  - It has been organized from 12 to 19 March 2021
  - **GAF** is the **largest Ayurvedic event** ever held anywhere across the world and witness the largest gathering of experts, stakeholders, and business explorers from Ayurveda.
  - Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industries (FICCI) is the festival and industry partner
- 22. Samsung Electronics set up Samsung innovation lab at Delhi Technological University (DTU) to promote joint research and training on domains such as artificial intelligence, machine learning and computer vision.
- 23. Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare Harsh Vardhan has been appointed as the Chairman of 'Stop TB Partnership Board' with effect from July 2021.
  - He will be serving at this post for **3-year tenure**.
- 24. IT major Amazon Web Services and NITI Aayog partnered to train students on the fundamentals of cloud computing through Atal Tinkering Labs.
  - **AWS** will introduce the fundamentals of cloud computing to students at more than **7,000** ATLs.
- 25. Union Health Minister, Harsh Vardhan has inaugurated Advanced High Resolution Microscopy Facility at National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute (NABI) and Unveiled the 4 Star GRIHA Certification of Center of Innovative and Applied Bioprocessing (CIAB) Lab and Admin Building at Mohali, Punjab

- 26. Union Cabinet has approved MoU between Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), India and Independent Administrative Reforms and Civil Services Commission (IARCSC), Afghanistan
  - The MoU will facilitate sharing of experience and expertise in the area of recruitment, books manuals and other documents which are not of a confidential nature and Information Technology for the preparation of written examinations and holding of Computer Based **Recruitment Tests** and Online Exams
- 27. Power Grid Corporation of India Limited has established an e-Tendering Portal-PRANIT.
- 28. CJI **Justice S A Bobde** has recommended the Union Government to appoint the senior-most Supreme Court Judge **Justice N V Ramanna** as the next Chief Justice of India.
- 29. Ministry of AYUSH has set up high level interdisciplinary committee to explore various aspects of the Productivity dimension of Yoga
  - Committee will be chaired by H. R Nagendra (Chancellor of Swami Vivekananda Yoga Anusandhana Samsthana)
- 30. Chief Justice of India S A Bobde has recommended Union Government to appoint senior most Supreme Court Judge N V Ramanna as the next Chief Justice of India
- 31. Govt is all set to roll out a GPS based toll collection system and introducing E-Highway from Delhi to Mumbai
  - Toll collection through fast tag has reached to 93% across the country which has resulted in 10 thousand crores more toll collection in comparison to previous year.
- 32. National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) will develop world class 'Wayside Amenities' at more than 600 locations across 22 states in 5 years
- 33. Health Minister **Dr Harsh Vardhan** has launched the '**Tribal TB Initiative**' in pursuit of TB Mukt Bharat.
- 34. The Union Territories of Lakshadweep and the **district of Badgam** in Jammu and Kashmir have been declared TB Free on World TB Day (24 March) this year.
- 35. IIT Kharagpur has emerged as winners at CoreNet Global Academic Challenge 6.0, sponsored by Cushman and Wakefield, KI and IA: Interior Architects.

- It is for the first time that a squad from India has emerged as winners in this Challenge since 2015.
- 36. Chief of Defence staff Bipin Rawat has formally commissioned Indian Coast Guard ship 'Vajra' nto service at Chennai.
- 37. Centre plans to issue 14-digit identification number termed as Unique Land Parcel Identification **Number (ULPIN)** to every plot of land in the country by 2022

#### STATES AFFAIRS

- 38. Nagaland Chief Minister **Neiphiu Rio** has launched its **first air cargo** services from **Dimapur airport**.
  - He officially flagged off the service, a joint initiative of **Department of Horticulture**, **Nagaland and** Airport Authority of India with Air India and Indigo as airline partners.
  - AAI is planning to construct terminal building including cargo service terminal at Dimapur
- 39. The Governor of Haryana, Satyadev Narayan Arya, has approved a bill to reserve 75 per cent jobs in **Private sector** jobs for the people of the state.
  - Reservation will be provided in every company, trust and society. Thus, the "Haryana State Employment of Local Candidates Act, 2020" has now come into force in the State.
- 40. Ladakh and Jammu and Kashmir will have a separate cell in National Commission for Women (NCW)
  - Ladakh became launching pad for the first-ever online training programme **Empowering Women** through Entrepreneurship.
  - It is being launched in collaboration with **IIM**, **Bangalore** and **India SME Forum**.
  - UT Administration will also provide women entrepreneurs with internet facilities or facilitate at a common point to participate in the training programs.
- 41. Karnataka has launched India's maiden Engineering Research & Development (ERD) policy to raise R&D contribution to 45% in 5 year.
  - This policy has the potential to create over 50,000 jobs in ERD space

- New policy has identified **5 key focus sectors**: aerospace and defence; auto, auto components and EV; biotechnology, pharma, medical devices; semiconductors, telecom; software products
- 42. Indian Army has inaugurated Community Radio Station in North Kashmir, with the tagline 'Radio Chinar 90.4, Har Dil Ki Dhadkan'.
- 43. Uttarakhand government has launched 'Gharoki Paachan, Chelik Naam' (daughter's name is a home's identity) programme and development schemes.
  - Around 32,000 women groups of the state are being linked with self-employment to make them selfreliant.
- 44. Tripura CM Biplab Kumar Deb has launched 'Jagrut Tripura' project to empower citizens of the northeastern state
  - It was developed by **EasyGov**, a Jio Group company, and it will be available to all the residents of Tripura.
  - The platform will have at least 102 schemes of various departments of central as well as state governments.
- 45. The first consignment of 'red rice' was flagged off on March 4, 2021 to the United States. This adds on to the India's rice exports potential. The rice was sourced by leading rice exporter called 'LT Foods'.
- 46. The government of Jharkhand have presented the "Outcome-Based Budget" on March 3, 2021 for the first time.
  - In this budget, all the departments were given specific targets and responsibilities that are required to be completed in a specified time. The results with respect to those targets will be evaluated at the end of financial year.
- 47. The state of Madhya Pradesh has introduced the night safaris in the three national parks in Madhya Pradesh on March 4, 2021. This move by the state is a major boost for the state which is already known for its robust tourism industry.
  - With the introduction of night safaris in three national parks, wildlife enthusiasts can now experience the majestic animals at night. The three parks include the Bandhavgarh National Park, Kanha National Park and Pench National Park.

- 48. Cyberabad police has inaugurated 'Transgender Community Desk' at Gachibowli Police Station in Rangareddy district, Telangana.
  - It is the first-of-its-kind gender inclusive community policing initiative of India
- 49. India's first-of-its-kind 'Forest Healing Centre' has been inaugurated at Kalika, Ranikhet in Uttarakhand
  - It is based on the concept of making people healthy by bringing them into direct contact with nature over 13 acres land
  - It is a pine-dominated forest, developed by research wing of Uttarakhand Forest Dept
  - It has various activities for visitors like hug trees, walk barefoot on the grass, lie on their back and gaze at the swaying trees
- 50. J&K Lt Governor Manoj Sinha has launched 'Super-75' scholarship schemes for meritorious girls to facilitate the education and entrepreneurship of women
- 51. The Mission Gramodaya has been launched in Madhya Pradesh.
  - Under the Gramodaya mission, besides providing housing facilities in rural areas, basic and fundamental infrastructure will also be expanded.
- 52. The Jharkhand govt launched the SAAMAR (Strategic Action for Alleviation of Malnutrition and **Anemia Reduction)** campaign to tackle malnutrition.
- 53. Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot announced to launch of the much anticipated Universal Health Scheme (UHS) "Mukhya Mantri Chiranjeevi Yojana".
- 54. Andhra Pradesh government has decided to set up "India's first government-run ambulance network" for animals
- 55. ITC Limited has entered into a partnership with the Government of Karnataka to execute a Watershed **Development Programme** covering over 1 million acres and 100 watersheds across the State.
- 56. Minister of State for Civil Aviation, Hardeep Singh Puri has virtually inaugurated Kurnool Airport in Andhra Pradesh
  - Flight operations at Kurnool will begin from 28 March 2021

- It has been developed under Regional Connectivity Scheme, Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik (RCS-UDAN)
- 57. Hyderabad-based startup, Maithri Aquatech has set up world's first mobile water from air kiosk and Water Knowledge Resource Centre in Visakhapatnam
  - Through this, potable water will be harvested from air instead of depending on water resources
- 58. Education Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' has virtually inaugurated Anandam: The Center for Happiness in Indian Institute of Management, Jammu
  - Centre will be divided into 5 categories: counselling, holistic wellness, elective courses on happiness development, Research-Leadership and faculty development

#### INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

- 59. Russian space corporation 'Roscosmos' has successfully launched its first satellite to monitor the Arctic's climate and environment.
  - This satellite is titled as 'Arktika-M' and was launched onboard Soyuz-2.1b carrier rocket, from Baikonur Cosmodrome in Kazakhstan.
  - This satellite will help to collect information to solve operational meteorology and hydrology problems, and monitoring the climate and environment in the Arctic region, Earth's northern polar region.
- 60. Indian Air Force (IAF) with six Su-30 MKI, two C-17 and one IL-78 tanker aircraft is participating in Exercise Desert Flag-VI for the first time Desert Flag-VI
  - It has been organized from March 3 to 27, 2021 at Al-Dhafra airbase, UAE.
  - It is an annual multi-national large force employment warfare exercise hosted by UAE Air Force.
  - Participants: UAE, USA, France, Saudi Arabia, South Korea and Bahrain
  - It involves diverse fighter aircraft.
- 61. The scientists have discovered a "space hurricane" for the first time. The hurricane swirled for eight hours over the North Pole in the upper atmosphere of Earth.
  - These hurricanes are usually occurred in the lower atmosphere of the Earth. It was never observed in the upper atmosphere.
- 62. The Union Ministry of Earth Science announced that India have agreed to work in collaboration with **Norway** in the area of **marine spatial planning** of the oceanic space for next five years.

- 63. India was downgraded to 'partly free' for the first time since 1997 in an annual ranking of democracies by the U.S.-government funded research group **Freedom House**
- 64. United Nations General Assembly has adopted a resolution sponsored by India and supported by 70 nations declaring 2023 as the International Year of Millets
- 65. France has launched its first military exercise in space to evaluate its ability to defend its satellites and other defence equipment from an attack.
  - It has been codenamed as 'AsterX' in memory of the first French satellite from 1965 and will be based on 18 simulated events
- 66. China has signed MoU with Russia to jointly construct a lunar space station that will be open to all countries.
  - This Lunar space station will be known as **International Scientific Lunar Station (ISLS)**
  - ISLS: Complex of experimental and research facilities, created on the moon's surface or in orbit of the moon.
- 67. Quadrilateral Framework (QUAD) Leader's Summit 2021 has been held.
  - Prime Minister Narendra Modi, U.S. President Joseph Biden, Australian PM Scott Morrison and Japanese PM Yoshihide Suga addressed 1st virtual Quadrilateral Framework (Quad) summit 2021
  - It is first time leaders of the Indo-Pacific grouping (QUAD) are meeting.
- 68. World's most powerful supercomputer named 'Fugaku' is made fully operational.
  - It has been developed by Japanese scientific research institute RIKEN and Fujitsu.
- 69. Italy has signed amended Framework Agreement of International Solar Alliance (ISA) with India
  - The amendments to the **ISA Framework agreement** entered into force in Jan 8, 2021, opening its membership to all Member States of the UN, including those lying beyond the tropics.
- 70. Ajay Mathur has assumed the charge as the Director General of International Solar Alliance (ISA) with effect from March 15, 2021.
  - He has been appointed for tenure of 4 years which can be renewed for an additional term.

- 71. Singapore is building world's largest floating solar farms of the world to support the effort against climate change
  - It will be **60 mw-peak floating solar system** with 1200 panels and is being built at **Tengeh** Reservoir by Sembcorp Industries in collaboration with Singapore Public Utilities Board
- 72. Norwegian Coastal Administration has received green signal to construct World's first exclusive ship tunnel, known as Stad Ship Tunnel
  - It will be built under mountainous **Stadhavet peninsula** in northwestern Norway.
- 73. Russian space agency 'Roscosmos' has successfully launched 38 foreign satellites into orbit, onboard Soyuz-2.1a carrier rocket from **Baikonur cosmodrome** in Kazakhstan
- 74. Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) members states, including India, Pakistan and China will hold joint anti-terrorism exercise titled 'Pabbi-Anti-Terror 2021'
  - It will be hosted by Pakistan at its premier anti-terrorism centre in **Pabbi, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**
- 75. India and US conducted two-day naval PASSEX exercise in Bay of Bengal, reflecting the growing congruence in defence and military partnership
  - Exercise was held from 28th to 29th March
- 76. Indian Navy will participate in France-led naval drill named as 'La Perouse' in the Bay of Bengal.
- 77. The exercise will be held from **April 5 to 7, 2021.** 
  - Participating nations also include Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (QUAD) member countries: Australia, Japan and United States of America (USA).

### REPORTS & INDICES

- 78. Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs has released Municipal Performance Index (MPI) 2020
  - Indore has emerged as the highest ranked municipality, followed by Surat and Bhopal in Million+ population category
  - New Delhi Municipal Council has emerged as the leader, followed by Tirupati and Gandhinagar in less than Million population category

- MPI has examined sectoral performance of 111 municipalities across five verticals, 20 sectors and 100 indicators in all totality.
- 79. Bengaluru emerged as the best city in Government's Ease of Living Index 2020 [EoLI], followed by **Pune** and **Ahmedabad**, including 111 other cities.
  - Shimla was ranked the highest in ease of living in the category of 'population less than million', followed by **Bhubaneshwar** and **Silvassa**
  - **EoLI** is an **assessment tool** that evaluates the quality of life and the impact of various initiatives for urban development, spanning across 13 categories, account for 70% of overall outcome.
- 80. QS World University Rankings by Subject has been released with Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), US at the top.
  - As 25 courses by Indian universities have figured in the top 100 globally:
  - Three Indian Institutes of Technology have entered the top 100 engineering institutes with IIT-Bombay (49th) followed by IIT Delhi (54) and IIT Madras (94). MIT, USA has retained its top position.
  - IISc, Bangalore is placed at the 92nd spot for natural sciences.
- 81. Recently, a report was commissioned by the Amazon Web Services (AWS) on India's Digital skilled workforce. The report highlights that, digital skills are becoming a significant component for employees in order to perform their jobs efficiently
- 82. The United Nation Environment Programme (UNEP) published the "Food Waste Index Report, 2021". As per the UNEP report, estimated **931 million tonnes** of food were wasted across the world 2019. The agency also highlighted that this amount of wasted food can circle the Earth seven times.
- 83. The World Health Organization (WHO) has published the first world report on hearing on World Hearing Day which was observed on March 3, 2021.
  - In the new report, the WHO has highlighted that, one in every four individuals across the world will be experiencing mild-to-profound hearing loss by 2050, which roughly accounts for 2.5 billion
  - 84. FICCI's Overall Business Confidence Index has been released that witnessed decadal high of 74.2 in the current round on account of improvement in present conditions as well as expectations
    - The Index had stood at **70.9 in 2020** survey and **59 in 2019 survey**

- 85. United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and WRAP has released Food Waste Index **Report 2021** to cut food waste to half by 2030
  - It estimates that around 931 million tonnes of food waste was generated in 2019
  - Out of which, 61% came from households, 26% from food service and 13% from retail
  - Around 17% of total global food production was wasted
  - About 690 million people went hungry in 2019
  - In India, household food waste is about 68.7 million tonnes a year
- 86. Singapore has topped in Economic Freedom Index 2021, for 2nd year in row with overall score of 89.7, followed by New Zealand and Australia
  - The index is published by US conservative think-tank, **The Heritage Foundation**
  - It covered **184 countries** that covered the period from July 2019 to June 2020
  - India has been placed at 121 position in the index, with a score of 56.5 out of 100 under Mostly Unfree category
  - Among Asia-Pacific countries, **India ranks 26 out of 40 countries**

- 87. Hurun India Wealth Report 2020 has been released. According, to the report, there are 412,000 dollar-millionaire households/affluent households in India with net worth of Rs 7 crore.
  - Top 10 states that are home to 70.3% of millionaire households in India: Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Gujarat.
- 88. New Delhi has been ranked as the 10th most polluted city in World's most polluted capital city for 3rd straight year, in 2020 World Air Quality Report by Swiss organisation, IQAir
  - Top most polluted city of the world: Xinjiang, China
- 89. Sweden-based Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) released report titled 'Trends in International Arms Transfers-2020'
  - As per the report, imports of weapons and military equipment of India declined by **33%** during 2016-2020

- India continues to be 2nd largest World importer, despite import rates cut
- Largest arms importers: Saudi Arabia, India, Egypt, Australia, China
- Largest arms exporters: **US, Russia, France, Germany, China.** India ranked 24th in this
- 90. UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network has released the World Happiness Report 2021.
  - **Finland** was once again crowned as the world's happiest country.
  - **India** has been ranked **139** out of **149** countries.
  - **Denmark** ranked 2nd followed by **Switzerland**, **Iceland** and the **Netherlands**.
  - **Afghanistan** was classed as the world's unhappiest nation this year.
- 91. UN Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) has projected India's economy contraction by 6.9% in 2020 due to coronavirus pandemic.
- 92. India has been ranked 40th in International Intellectual Property (IP) Index 2021 among 53 global economies
  - IP Index 2021 was released by US Chamber of Commerce Global Innovation Policy Centre (GIPC)
  - US bags top spot in the index, followed by UK and Germany

  - As per the report, despite COVID-19 pandemic, year **2020 was the best year in history for the** global wind industry as this sector installed 93GW of new capacity in 2020, representing a 53% year-on-year increase.
  - There is now 743 GW of wind power capacity worldwide, helping to avoid over 1.1 billion tonnes of CO2 globally.
- 94. World Bank has released World Development Report 2021: Data for Better Lives
  - The report focuses on how data can improve the lives of poor people and advance development objectives, to ensure no one is left behind
  - It highlights the tremendous potential of the changing data landscape to improve the lives of poor people, acknowledging its potential to open back doors that can harm individuals, businesses and societies
  - India monitors 54 out of 130 SDG indicators.

- 95. World Health Organization (WHO) is all set to release long-awaited report on the origin of the coronavirus (Covid-19)
  - The report has been drafted by a team of international experts appointed by WHO, who visited China's Wuhan city
  - According to the preliminary information on the study, researchers have found that Covid-19 most likely transmitted to humans via animals. However, report offers no conclusive answers to the origin questions.

- 96. The Office of Principal Scientific Adviser of the Government of India has launched the "Swachhta Saarthi Fellowship" under the "Waste to Wealth" Mission on March 3, 2021.
  - The Swachhta Saarthi Fellowship initiative was launched with the objective of recognizing the students, self-help groups, community workers, sanitary workers and municipal workers who are engaged in tackling enormous challenge of waste management in a scientific and sustainable manner.
  - Under the fellowship programme, the government will be providing awards under three categories as stated below:
  - Category-A- This category will be open to School students of standards 9th to 12th who are engaged in the waste management community work.
  - Category-B— This category is open to UG, PG and Research Students engaged in the waste management community work.
  - Category-C: This category of the fellowship is open to the Citizens who are working in the community and through Self Help Groups, municipal workers or sanitary workers who are working beyond the specifications of their job requirements.
- 97. Union Minister Harsh Vardhan has virtually launched the 'CSIR Floriculture Mission'.

- CSIR Floriculture Mission has been recently approved for implementation in 21 States and UT of India wherein available knowledgebase in CSIR Institutes will be utilized and leveraged to help Indian farmers and industry re-position itself to meet the import requirements.
- Floriculture is concerned with growing and marketing flowers and ornamental plants as well as a flower arrangement.
- The floriculture mission is being implemented in association with Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Directorate of Floriculture, Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India Ltd. (TRIFED) etc.
- This mission will converge the floriculture with apiculture to yield benefits. The mission will focus on the commercial crops for honeybee rearing such as Gladiolus, Carnation, Canna, Marigold, Rose etc.
- 98. Union Minister for Labour has launched convergence of ESI Scheme with Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (ABPM-JAY) in 113 districts of Chhatisgarh, Karnataka, MP and Maharashtra.
- 99. Convergence Energy Services Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Energy Efficiency Services Ltd (EESL), unveiled the GRAM UJALA programme.
  - Under the programme, high-quality energy-efficient **LED bulbs** will be given for **Rs 10 per piece** in certain villages of five states in the first phase.
  - The programme will be financed entirely through carbon credits and will be the first such programme in India.
  - In phase-I of the programme, 15 million LED bulbs will be distributed
- 100. PM Narendra Modi has launched 'Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain' campaign on World Water Day (22nd March)
  - Campaign will run till 30th Nov, 2021
  - It will be undertaken across the country, in **734 districts** covering **600,000 villages** with theme 'catch the rain, where it falls, when it falls'
  - It will be launched as Jan Andolan to take water conservation at grass-root level through people's participation. During this, geotagging of all water bodies will be carried out.

101. Union Environment Minister, **Prakash Javadekar** has launched new **Nagar Van Scheme** for creation of Urban forests in the cities on the occasion of International Day of Forests

- Under Nagar Van Scheme, Urban forests will be developed in 200 cities in its first phase.
- **Drone mapping water conservation** and tree plantation were also taken into consideration.

  - He belongs to Hisar district of Haryana.
- 177. Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir has topped medals tally in the 2nd edition of Khelo India Winter National Games
  - Khelo India Winter National Games was five-day mega sports event that was held at Gulmarg in Baramulla, north Kashmir
  - J&K won 11 gold, 18 silver and 5 bronze medals. It was followed by Karnataka and Maharashtra
  - It was organized by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports in collaboration with J&K Sports Council and J&K Winter Games Association

- 178. World Championship bronze medallist wrestler, Bajrang Punia won a gold medal at Matteo **Pallicone** ranking series held in Rome, Italy.
  - He defeated Mongolia's **Tulga Tumur Ochir** by 2-2 in 65kg freestyle event final.
  - Apart from this, ace India woman wrestler Vinesh Phogat (26 years) won gold medal in the **53kg title**, after beating Canada's Diana Weicker by 4-0
- 179. India's ace shuttler PV Sindhu has won silver medal in BWF Swiss Open Super 300 in final of women's singles event held at Basel
  - She lost to World No. 3 and reigning Olympic champion Carolina Marin.
- 180. India's off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin has been named as the ICC Men's Player of the Month for February 2021.
- 181. Veteran cricketer Mithali Raj (38 years) became first Indian woman cricketer to complete 10,000 runs across all formats.
  - With this, she also became the 2nd largest woman scorer in international cricket
- 182. Virat Kohli has become 1st-ever batsman to score 3,000 runs in T-20 International
  - He achieved this milestone during **2nd T20-International against England** at Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad, in which unbeaten knock of 73 runs and crossed 3,000-run mark.
- 183. Youth Affairs & Sports Minister Kiren Rijiju has announced to set up Winter Sports Institute in Gulmarg, Kashmir.
  - He also announced inauguration of **100 small sports centres** under **Khelo India mission**.
- 184. Tamil Nadu's Chadalavada Anandha Bhavani Devi (27 years) became the first-ever fencer from India to quality for Olympic Games.
  - She secured a spot for the Tokyo Olympics at the World Cup in Hungary.
- 185. Indian athlete Avinash Sable set a new national record in men's 3000m steeplechase event in ongoing Federation Cup Senior National Athletics Championships in Patiala with 8:20.20 timing.
- 186. India bagged 3rd position at the end of 2021 World Shooting Para Sport competitions with seven medals, held at Al Ain in UAE from 15 to 25 March 2021.
- 187. Indian contingent emerged successful in ISSF World Cup in the Trap events with 30 medals in total (15 gold, 9 silver and 6 bronze)

- Indian trio of Shreyasi Singh, Manisha Keer and Rajeshwari Kumari won the gold medal in women's Trap Team event.
- India outgunned the Kazakhstan trio 6-0 in the final
- 188. Tokyo 2020 Olympic Torch Relay kicked off in Fukushima, Japan.
  - The torch relay will travel through all the 47 districts of Japan over the next 121 days.
  - It will arrive in Tokyo for the Olympic Games Opening Ceremony that will be held on July 23.
  - Japanese footballer **lwashimizu Azusa** is the first receiver of this Olympic Torch Relay.
