- 1. Ministry of Labour & Employment has notified Section 142 of Social Security Code, 2020 covering applicability of Aaadhar.
  - It will enable the Ministry to collect Aaadhar details for the database of beneficiaries under various social security schemes.
  - Under this, National Data Base for unorganized workers (NDUW) will be framed, which is at an advanced stage of development by National Informatics Centre.
  - It is aimed at collection of data for unorganized workers.
- 2. Ministry of Civil Aviation has granted conditional exemption to conduct Beyond Visual Line of Sight (BVLOS) experimental flights of drones from Unmanned Aircraft System {UAS} Rules, 2021 to 20
  - Preliminary permission grant is envisioned to assist supplementary framework of subsequent UAV rules pertaining to BVLOS drone operations.
  - BVLOS Experiment Assessment and Monitoring Committee has also been constituted
  - Indian Armed forces have launched operation 'CO-JEET' to aid anti-COVID-19 efforts like strengthening medical infrastructure and oxygen supply chains, as well as take measures to ensure mental wellbeing of people.

## STATES AFFAIRS

- 3. DMK leader M.K. Stalin (68 years) takes oath as the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu at Raj Bhavan.
  - His oath has been administered by TN Governor Banwarilal
- 4. Indian Army has launched first green solar energy plant in Sikkim to harness renewable energy
  - It will use vanadium-based battery technology, and has been built at an altitude of 16000 ft. in northern part of Sikkim and has a capacity of 56 KVA
- 5. NR Congress Chief N Rengasamy (70 years) will be sworn in as the Chief Minister of Union **Territory of Puducherry.** 
  - His oath was administered by Puducherry's Lieutenant Governor **Tamilisai Soundararajan**

## **INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS**

- 6. World's longest pedestrian suspension bridge, Arouca Bridge 516 and was officially inaugurated in northern Portugal.
  - The steel and concrete suspension bridge is a **1,693 ft (516 m) long** and 175 m (574 ft) above the Paiva River.

- 7. First-ever India-France-Australia Trilateral Foreign Ministerial Dialogue has been held in London, UK, on the sidelines of G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting.
  - Meeting was attended by External Affairs Minister, S. Jaishankar, France's Minister for Europe, Jean-Yves Le Drian and Australia's Senator Marise Payne.
  - France, India and Australia trilateral meet were launched in September 2020 at Foreign Secretaries' levels
  - G7: Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, UK, US
- 8. US will support World Trade Organisation (WTO) initiative to waive Trade Related Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS) protection for COVID-19 vaccines
  - TRIPS is Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights is an international legal agreement between all the member nations of WTO
  - It establishes minimum standards for the regulation by national govt of different forms of intellectual property (IP)
  - TRIPS is administered by the WTO.

### **REPORTS & INDICES**

- 9. The UN has released its Global Forest Goals Report 2021. The Report has been prepared by the **Department of Economic and Social Affairs** of the UN.
  - According to the report, the Covid-19 pandemic has aggravated the challenges faced by countries in managing their forests.
  - It provides an initial overview of the progress of Goals and targets contained within the United Nations Strategic Plan for Forests 2030.
  - According to the report, almost **25% global population** rely on forest.

## **GOVERNMENT SCHEMES & PROGRAMMES**

- 10. Govt has issued guidelines for 'Production Linked Incentive Scheme for the Food Processing **Industry'** (PLISFPI). Govt has also launched an online portal for the PLISFPI.
  - Govt has approved new Central Sector Scheme namely PLISFPI for implementation during 2021-22 to 2026-27 with an outlay of Rs 10,900 crore.
  - It aims to support creation of global food manufacturing champions and support Indian brands of food products in the international markets.

## **ECONOMY & BUSINESS**

- 11. **SIDBI** has launched two loan products at a concessional rate for ramping up supply of products used in the fight against the COVID-19 for MSMEs.
  - These products will help augment supply of oxygen cylinders, oxygen concentrators, oximeters, and essential drugs by MSMEs. These loan products are
  - **SHWAS** SIDBI assistance to Healthcare sector in War Against the Second wave of COVID19
  - **AROG** SIDBI Assistance to MSMEs for Recovery and Organic Growth during COVID19
- 12. Tribal Co-operative Marketing Federation of India (TRIFED) has signed MoU with The LINK **Fund** for a collaborative project titled 'Sustainable Livelihoods For Tribal Households in India'. The MoU will facilitate:
  - Tribal Development and Employment Generation
  - Sustainable livelihoods and value addition, produce and crafts diversification, skill training
  - The LINK Fund is a **Geneva**, **Switzerland** based philanthropic operational foundation.
- 13. Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has given its approval for strategic disinvestment along with transfer of management control of IDBI Bank Ltd.
  - The extent of shareholding to be divested by Govt and LIC shall be decided at the time of structuring of transaction in consultation with RBI
  - Govt and LIC together own more than 94% of equity of **IDBI Bank (Gol 45.48%, LIC 49.24%)**
  - LIC is currently the promoter of IDBI Bank with Management Control and Gol is the co-promote

### FINANCE & BANKING

- 14. **RBI** has joined group of Central Banks and Supervisors 'Network for Greening the Financial System (NGFS)' as a Member.
  - NGFS: Network of central banks and financial supervisors that are willing to share best practices and contribute to environment, climate risk management, mobilizing mainstream finance
  - NGFS was launched at Paris One Planet Summit on December 12, 2017.
  - NGFS HOs: Paris, France
- 15. **RBI** has imposed monetary penalty of **Rs 3 crores** on ICICI Bank for non-compliance with certain RBI directions in the matter of shifting of securities from one category to another
  - As per RBI, penalty has been imposed for contravention of certain in Master Circular of 2015 on 'Prudential Norms for Classification, Valuation and Operation of Investment Portfolio by Banks'
  - RBI has imposed this penalty in exercise of powers under provisions of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.
- 16. RBI has opened an on-tap liquidity window of Rs 50,000 crores to boost provision of immediate liquidity for ramping up Covid-related healthcare infrastructure and services in the country.

- It will have tenors of up to 3 years at repo rate (4%) till March 31, 2022
- Under this, banks can provide fresh lending support to wide range of entities including vaccine manufacturers, priority medical devices, treatment, etc.
- It will continue to be classified under priority sector
- 17. RBI Governor **Shaktikanta Das** has announced a **special long-term repo operation (SLTRO)** for small finance banks, amid the second wave of COVID-19 in India
- 18. RBI will conduct the **special operation of Rs 10,000 crore** at repo rate.
  - It will remain open till October 31, 2021.
  - To provide further support to small business units, micro and small industries, and other unorganized sector entities

#### **AWARDS & RECOGNISTION**

- 19. According to a report by **Brand Finance Insurance 100 2021** state-owned **LIC** has emerged as the third strongest and the tenth most valuable insurance brand globally.
  - As per the report, the total value of the world's top 100 most valuable insurance brands declined by 6% from \$462.4 billion in 2020 to \$433.0 billion in 2021.
  - However, **LIC's brand value increased by almost 7%** to \$8.65 billion
  - Brand Finance is a **London-based** brand valuation consultancy
- 20. Investigative journalist and media executive, **Maria Ressa (57 years)** of the Philippines has been

named as the winner of 2021 UNESCO/Guillermo Cano World Press Freedom Prize

• She was chosen because of her more than 3-decade dedication as a journalist, including her work as CNN's lead investigative reporter (Asia) and news chief of ABS-CBN

#### **PERSON IN NEWS**

- 21. Vaishali S Hiwase became the first woman officer to be appointed as officer commanding in the Border Roads Organisation.
  - She will be responsible for providing connectivity through an **Indo-China** border road.
- 22. Mahindra Group Chairman **Anand Mahindra** has rolled out a project titled as **'Oxygen on** Wheels' to ease the transportation of oxygen from plants to hospitals and homes, following acute oxygen shortage
- 23. RBI's executive director T Rabi Sankar has been named as the 4th Deputy Governor of RBI
  - He will succeed B P Kanungo, who retired on April 2

## **OBITUARIES**

- He was known for his contribution to the field of constitutional law.
- He had also helped India win in the **International Court of Justice** against **Pakistan** in the **Atlantique downing case** of 1999.
- 25. Sitar maestro Pandit Debu Chaudhuri (85 years) passed away due to COVID-19 related complications in New Delhi's Guru Teg Bahadur Hospital
  - He was known as Legend of Sitar and belonged to the Senia or Gharana style of music.
  - He had been awarded Padma Bhushan and the Padma Shri.

#### **IMPORTANT DAYS**

- 26. International Labour Day or International Workers' Day or May Day is being observed today (1st May) across the world.
- 27. World Press Freedom Day is being observed every year on 3rd May globally to discuss journalistic ethics and to celebrate journalists who gave their lives in the pursuit of truth.
  - The day also celebrates anniversary of **Declaration of Windhoek**
  - Theme 2021: Information as a Public Good
  - 2021 Global Conference is hosted by UNESCO and Govt of Namibia.

## **SPORTS**

- 28. Mercedes racer Lewis Hamilton (Great Britain) won the 2021 Portuguese Grand Prix, which was held at the **Algarve International Circuit in Portugal.** 
  - This was the second victory of the season for Hamilton and 96th career victory.
- 29. Mark Selby became the World Snooker Champion for the fourth time after defeating fellow mate Shaun Murphy by **18-15 victory** at Crucible Theatre, Sheffield, England.
