**IBPS PO Mains Descriptive Paper Syllabus****1. Essay Writing**

You will be required to write one essay of about 250 words. Topics are usually related to:

- **Current Affairs** (e.g., Digital India, Climate Change, Women Empowerment)
- **Social Issues** (e.g., Unemployment, Education Reform)
- **Economic Topics** (e.g., Budget, Inflation, Startups in India)
- **Technology & Environment** (e.g., AI, Renewable Energy)
- **Banking & Finance** (e.g., Financial Inclusion, Role of RBI)

**2. Letter Writing**

This part typically involves one letter (150–200 words). Letters can be:

- **Formal** (e.g., writing to a bank manager, editor, government official)
- **Informal** (e.g., writing to a friend or relative)

**Common Letter Topics:**

- Complaint or request to the bank authorities
- Suggestions to improve public service
- Letter to the editor expressing concern/opinion
- Personal letters, like congratulating a friend or sharing advice
